 Top Ten Mouse Commands

1	<b>MouseGrid</b>	places a mouse grid over the full screen	number commands will zoom the grid in and then a <b>mouse click</b> command may be used
2	<b>MouseGrid Window</b>	places a mouse grid over an active window	
3	<b>Mouse click</b> <b>Mouse double click</b> <b>Mouse right click</b>	to activate mouse clicks in MouseGrid	
4	<b>Mark</b> <b>Drag</b>	to mark and drag an object...example: <b>MouseGrid 9 1 Mark</b> <b>MouseGrid 6 3 Drag</b>	
5	<b>Cancel</b>	closes MouseGrid	
6	<b>Mouse up</b> <b>Mouse right</b> <b>Mouse down</b> <b>Mouse left</b>	will move the mouse cursor in direction specified	alternative: <b>Mouse right 5</b>  moves the cursor five steps
7	<b>Fast</b> <b>Faster</b> <b>Much Faster</b> <b>Very Fast</b> <b>Slow</b> <b>Slower</b> <b>Much Slower</b> <b>Very Slow</b>	all of these speed options may be used to change the speed of the mouse cursor movement	

8	<b>Stop</b>	stops the mouse cursor movement
9	<b>Click</b> <b>Double click</b> <b>Right click</b>	used for mouse click events
10	<b>Click &lt;option&gt;</b>	clicks on the option named...examples: button, tabs, menu items, dialog box options, etc.
